

Telemedicine Highlights

Generally speaking, telemedicine is the use of electronic communication devices (computer, phones, etc.) to conduct provider services at a distance. There are 3 legal considerations for Telemedicine: state license, reimbursement and consent.



- The state where the physician is located (probably already licensed here); **AND**
- The state in which the patient is physically located (this is where it gets complicated)
